2024 WAPT Higher Education Scholarship

- Who may apply? Who may apply? Any graduating (or who has graduated within the past 3 school years) Washington State High School Senior seeking higher education, whose parent / guardian is a member in good standing of WAPT. Non-member's students are encouraged to apply also, but a completed membership application, available on line at www.wapt4u.org and payment of appropriate membership dues must be submitted with the scholarship application. We ask that the student complete the application, not the parent / guardian.
- <u>Do I have to be going to a four-year college or university</u>? No. Students who are pursuing higher education at any public or private, vocational, technical, two-year College, four-year University or Trade School may apply.
- What does the scholarship consist of? The WAPT awards two cash scholarships of \$1,000.00 each year. One to an Eastside WAPT Chapter student and one to a Westside WAPT Chapter student.
- When do I receive my scholarship? The recipient of the scholarship will be recognized at
 the WAPT June conference and payment will be sent to the Students College account prior to the
 start of the next semester/Quarter. A copy of the students registration submitted to the chairman of
 the awards committee will enable the Treasurer to award the scholarship check to the school.
- How do I apply? Complete and sign the attached WAPT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION to include:
 - 1. HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS
 - LETTER OF CHARACTER REFERENCE (Someone other than a relative please).
 - 3. STATEMENT OF GOALS AND OBJECTIVES IN SEEKING HIGHER EDUCATION (200 words or less please).
 - 4. Fifty dollar membership dues (if applicable)
- Who decides the scholarship awardee? The WAPT Scholarship committee.
- <u>Is there a deadline for scholarship applications</u>? Yes. Please have your completed application postmarked no later than April 5th, 2024.

- Is there a deadline for use? Yes, it must be used within one year.
